

RESOLUTION #21

Subject: **MSNJ Effect on County Medical Society Income**

Referred to: Reference Committee

1 Whereas, MSNJ has entered into an agreement for the payment of dues with the New Jersey
2 Psychiatric Association without consultation with the county medical societies; and

4 Whereas, the MSNJ agreement for payment of dues with the New Jersey Psychiatric
5 Association adversely affects the income of the county medical societies; and

7 Whereas, MSNJ has adopted the “Twin Program” that also reduces payment of dues to
8 county medical societies; and

10 Whereas, MSNJ decided, without consultation with the county medical societies, that the
11 AMA rebate program to county medical societies should be discontinued; and

13 Whereas, the decision to discontinue the AMA rebate program adversely affects the income
14 of the county medical societies; and

16 Whereas, MSNJ may consider other agreements with other entities in the future; now
17 therefore be it

19 RESOLVED, that any financial agreements between MSNJ and any entities that may affect
20 dues income shall only be binding for MSNJ and not an individual county medical society or
21 the county medical societies as a whole.
